## Director of Mission's Report

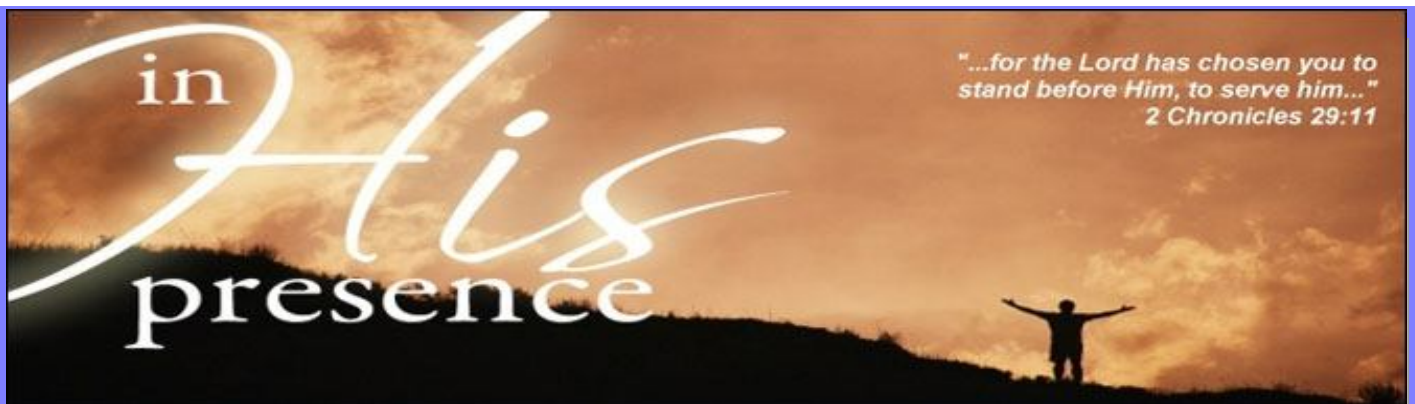
"In everything give thanks: for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you." 1Thessalonians 5:18
