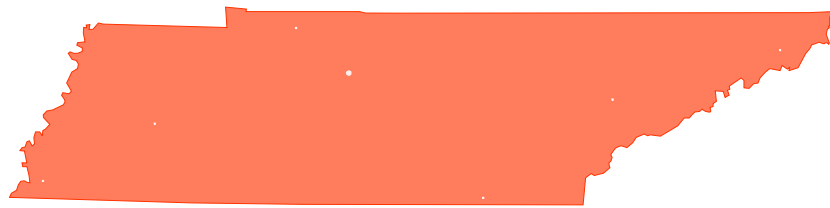

## Articles of Faith of the Stewart County Baptist Association

The Articles of Faith of the Stewart County Baptist Association shall be **THE BAPTIST FAITH AND MESSAGE** as adopted by the Southern Baptist Convention, May 9, 1963.

### Constitution Of the Stewart County Baptist Association

1. This Association shall be composed of Messengers from only Missionary Baptist Churches which, are affiliated with the Southern Baptist Convention and shall be called the Stewart County Baptist Association.
2. Each Church shall be entitled to six messengers, and six alternates, plus the pastor. An alternate may be substituted in the event of a duly elected messenger being unable to attend. **THE MESSENGERS AND ALTERNATES MUST BE ELECTED BY THE CHURCH AND RECORDED ON THE ANNUAL ASSOCIATIONAL LETTER. THERE SHALL NOT BE ANY PROXY (SUBSTITUTE) MESSENGERS.**
3. The object of the Association shall not be to exercise ecclesiastical authority over the churches, but to promote love and spiritual unity and advance the cause of Missions.
4. The Association shall elect annually a Moderator (the term of office shall not exceed two consecutive years), Vice-Moderator, Clerk, and Treasurer, whose duties shall be those usual for their office. Their term of office shall begin at the close of the last session of the Annual Associational Meeting. The above named officers shall be our standing Associational Program Committee. The Moderator and Missionary shall be ex-officio members of all committees of the Association.
5. The Moderator shall appoint a nominating committee of seven people which, said Committee shall nominate all committees and chairman of standing committees or any other position not provided for by the annual meeting as needed. The committee shall present their report to Annual Association on the first day of the Association's action. The nominating committee shall maintain a rotating system of committee structure.
6. Corresponding messengers and others, not members of the Association may be entitled to seats with the privileges of speaking but not voting.
7. The Clerk shall send to each Church a number of Minutes in proportion to its contribution to the printing fund.
8. A majority of the messengers in attendance shall constitute a quorum.
9. This Association, by two-thirds vote, may refuse to receive the messengers of a church considered irregular in faith and practice.
10. This Association shall be governed by Robert's Rules of Order in all points not provided by this constitution.
11. No amendment shall be made to this constitution except by two-thirds vote.
12. This association shall provide an **EXECUTIVE BOARD** which, shall transact business matters; promote and direct the work of the Association between the sessions of the association. The Executive Board shall meet regularly, once each quarter, with provision being made for special called meetings. A one week notification by mail or phone shall be required for all special called meetings of the Executive Board. The Executive Board shall be composed of all pastors of the churches and one member who is elected by each church, plus all department heads of the Association and the Clerk and Treasurer of the Association. The Clerk, Treasurer and Parliamentarian of the Association also will serve on the Executive Board. Fifteen members shall constitute a Quorum. This Board shall elect its Chairman (the term of office shall not exceed two consecutive years) and Vice Chairman annually.

# Minutes

104th Annual Meeting  
106<sup>th</sup> year  
Stewart County Baptist Association  
Pleasant Grove Baptist Church  
October 18, 2007

Moderator Mudge asked Bro. Melvin Dunaway, Pastor of Pleasant Grove to come and open meeting with prayer. Bro. Dunaway asked we dedicate our service to the Lord. The meeting was convened at 5:45 p.m. by Moderator Roland Mudge, after a wonderful meal furnished by Pleasant Grove.

Moderator Mudge thanked Pleasant Grove for the use of the beautiful facility and a wonderful meal. He then introduced Sister Beverly Smothers from the Tennessee Baptist Center to share her information with the group. Sister Smothers stated that of the more than 6 million individuals who live in TN more than half of them are un-churched. She stated we needed to be proud of the participation in the TBC and they were open to suggestions and/or comments.

Moderator Mudge then asked Sister Sherry Johnson from the Tennessee Baptist Children's Home to speak. Sister Johnson spoke of the programs that assisted with their sponsorship; Mother's Day Offering, and Cooperative Program. She explained by working at the Children's home, she is allowed to see something new every day even after 24 years of service.

Moderator Mudge then requested Bro. Gray to give the Good Samaritans Report in Marcia Robertson's absence. Good Samaritans need more Christian volunteers and are helping hundreds of residents yearly. He invited all to come by and see the renovations and get involved. Good Samaritans is not a handout, but is to assist those working poor, who are not making enough to get by. Bro. Gray stressed how they appreciated all those who volunteer. Moderator Mudge then proceeded to the Department Head reports which were attached to the handout.

Bro. Russell Luffman came and lead the gathering in singing "When the Roll is called up Yonder, I'll be there". Pleasant Grove presented the special music for the evening with presentations of "Beulah Land" and "Then He'd have to Walk Through The Blood".

Moderator Mudge requested Bro. Vernon Wade to come give the Doctrinal message. Bro. Wade's message was titled "Call of Holiness thru Church Discipline". The message came from 1 Corinthians 5: 1-13. He spoke about truth, judgment, and discipline, getting our own houses in order, removing false teachers from churches and teaching the Bible.

Moderator Mudge then called the meeting to order and asked the Clerk for the "Seating of Messengers". Messengers were seated and Moderator Mudge asked for a motion for Adoption of Program, motion made, seconded, motion was carried to accept.

Bro. Gray asked Bro. Shannon give his Assistant Report first, then he gave the D.O.M. Missionary Report. Bro. Shannon thanked the Association for allowing him to work with them, thanked Dover First Baptist and Big Rock for their assistance with Grace. Bro. Gray asked all to turn to page 5 of the handout to review his report. He asked for prayer requests for the following: Bro. Wray Forrest, Bro. George and Mary Wyatt, Bro. Pat and Virgie Merrell, Bro. Royce Dukes and family, Bro. Gray and family for his brother, all churches and pastors.

Moderator Mudge asked for New Pastors and Staff to stand; Bro. Royce Dukes, Dover First, was the only new member. Moderator Mudge asked the Clerk for the Digest of Church Letters, Sister Jackson reviewed the

church letters and any changes be submitted to the Associational office no later than Monday. Sister Hicklen presented the Treasurer's Report with a balance on hand of \$9012.00. Moderator Mudge asked for concerns discussions, there were no, then requested a motion to accept reports as presented. Motion made, seconded and motion carried.

Moderator Mudge asked Bro. Gray to give the Budget Committee's report. The budget is an increase of \$247.00 a month over last years budget, since this is coming from Committee will only need a second. Motion was seconded and motion from the Budget Committee carried.

### **DISASTER RELIEF**

Our first trip was to Granite City, Ill. were on July 19th and 21st, 2006 where tornadoes had struck the city. Our team checked in with the Cumberland Baptist Association Disaster Relief team. We went in and gutted flooded homes so they could dry out and be repaired. This trip last 6 days.
